

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'BLOW'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
blow someone away/be blown away	to amaze someone	I watched a really good film about aliens, the special effects blew me away.
blow off	release pressure	I'll take the kids to the park; they need to blow off some steam.
blow out	extinguish a fire with your mouth	Can you close the window? The gas has already blown out twice.
blow over	pass without anything bad happening	Just keep your head down for a few weeks and it will all blow over.
blow up	inflate with air, enlarge, use explosives to destroy	I need to stop by the garage on the way home, my tyres need blowing up.
