

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'DRAW'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
draw back	retreat/move backwards	The man drew back when he came across a snake in his path.
draw in	pull towards	The band drew in a great crowd for their opening performance.
draw into	attract someone or something	I've brightened up the window display. I want to draw more customers into the shop.
draw out	make something longer than needed	I've got to seal 100 envelopes; I'm going to draw it out for the whole morning.
draw up	prepare a contract, document, plan, list etc.	I'll draw up the itinerary for our weekend in London, I don't want to miss anything.
draw upon	use your knowledge, skills, strength etc.	Tony drew upon his ICT skills to fix the broken computer.
