

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'EAT'

| phrasal verb | meaning | example |
|--------------|--|--|
| eat in | eat at home | I ate in all last week, I deserve a treat tonight. |
| eat into | use up more than necessary | I can only call for 10 minutes, otherwise it will eat into my revision time. |
| eat out | eat at a restaurant | We've already eaten out twice this week. |
| eat up | eat everything or use a lot of time or money | If you eat up your dinner, you can have ice cream after. |
