

## PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'GIVE'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
give + reflexive pronoun + up	surrender to the police	The gang gave themselves up as their hideaway was surrounded by armed police.
give away	distribute something for free, tell a secret	I've bought mum a puppy! Don't give it away, I want it to be a complete surprise.
give back	return something you borrowed, or someone has lost	I gave back the money you lent me last week. Have you forgotten?
give in	surrender or submit and essay, a form, homework etc.	I gave in my final assignment then headed straight to the pub.
give in to	let your desires control you or reluctantly agree to something	I'll have to give in to the kids and let them have a puppy.
give off	emit something	My small torch gives off a lot of light.
give out	distribute or emit	The crowd gave out a huge cheer when he won the Oscar.
give over	stop doing something annoying or pass the responsibility to another	When Terry got too old, he gave the company over to his son.
give up	stop doing something or surrender	I give up! Tell me the answer.
give up on	lose faith in something	I gave up on my team winning the league months ago.
