

## PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'HANG'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
hang about/around	spend time somewhere with no aim or purpose	You need to stop hanging around with Tony, he`s a bad influence.
hang back	stay behind, stay in the background	I`ll meet you in the office. I`ll hang back for a bit; I`m expecting a parcel.
hang in (there)	try and be positive, continue fighting	Hang in there, it`ll all be over in a week.
hang on	wait a short time	I`m leaving now. I`ve been hanging on for long enough.
hang on to	hold something	Can you hang on to my glasses before I lose them?
hang out	chill, relax with friends	Let`s go and hang out at the beach, it`s a nice day.
hang up	suspend an item in the air, end a phone call	The gas company keeps hanging up on me. I guess they don`t want my money!
hang with (someone)	spend time with someone	Are you alone? Do you want to come and hang with me?
