

## PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'JUMP'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
jump at	eagerly accept an opportunity	I jumped at the chance to go and work in Germany for 3 months.
jump in	enter something	I jumped in and told the whole room what I thought of the expansion plans.
jump off	leap off a surface	The baby goats are jumping off their shelters and running around the enclosure.
jump on	physically/verbally attack someone/something or climb onto	The whole court jumped on the suspect when he was found guilty.
jump over	leap across something	The stuntman's biggest stunt is jumping over 8 cars on his motorbike.
