

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'LAY'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
lay down	establish rules or place something onto a surface	The Police are laying down the law to my son. He was caught graffitiing the town hall.
lay into	fiercely shout at or beat someone	The shop keeper caught the thief stealing and laid into him with a baseball bat.
lay off	make someone redundant or stop doing something annoying/bad	It's about time you laid off George. You're bullying him.
lay on	provide something	The council are laying on extra trains during December.
lay out	arrange/display something or knock someone unconscious	The catering staff laid out all of the table decorations ready for the wedding.
