

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'LEAVE'

| phrasal verb | meaning | example |
|--------------|------------------------------------|--|
| leave at | a time to leave | We`ll be leaving at 10 o`clock on the dot. |
| leave behind | forget | I left my sunglasses behind. |
| leave for | exit to go to a place | I leave for work soon. |
| leave in | go at a certain time, don't delete | Leave section 13 in, I'll go through it. |
| leave off | exclude, stop doing something | The waitress left off that third bottle of wine, she`s a sweetheart. |
| leave on | a date you exit | If she leaves on Sunday, she`ll be back on Monday night. |
| leave out | omit, forget | Everyone has a girlfriend except me, I feel left out. |
