

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'PACK'

| phrasal verb | meaning | example |
|--------------|---|--|
| pack away | put things where they belong | Christmas is over, it's time to pack away the decorations. |
| pack in | stop doing something or a machine stops working | My phone has finally packed in, I need to buy a new one. |
| pack it in | stop doing something annoying | If you don't pack in your whining, I won't buy you any sweets. |
| pack off | send someone away to a different place | My parents packed me off to boarding school as soon as I was old enough. |
| pack out | fill a venue | We need to pack out the arena or we won't make any money. |
| pack up | finish work, stop doing something or something breaks | I'll pack up boxing classes next year, I can't afford them anymore. |
