

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'RING'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
ring around/round	call lots of people to organise something or get information	We're 2 players short, I'll ring round the lads to see who can play.
ring back	return a phone call	I'll be ringing my cousin back in a minute, don't worry.
ring in	telephone to tell, confirm or enter a competition	I rang in to a competition yesterday and won a brand new car!
ring out	a sudden loud noise	The church bells rang out as the newlyweds left for their reception.
ring up	call someone	I'll ring up the school tomorrow and find out when the kids break up for Easter.
