

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'SEND'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
send away	make someone leave	I went to the doctors, but she sent me away and told me I was overreacting.
send back	return something	I bought some new boots, but I sent them back. I couldn't really afford £50.
send for	ask for someone to come and help or request something	I've sent for the new catalogue, but it hasn't arrived yet.
send in	enter information, arrange for people to deal with a problem	I sent in my recipe to a TV show and they made it live.
send off	remove a player from a game or post something	I've sent off 8 application forms today. Hopefully I get a job soon.
send on	forward	I'll look through the document then send it on to the boss when I'm done.
send out	order out of a room or send to lots of people	I sent out the memo this morning. Did you not receive it?
