

## PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'THROW'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
throw at	throw towards a person/target	I packed up all his belongings and threw them at him when he got home.
throw away	discard something	I've thrown away everything that reminds me of my ex.
throw in	add something	I bought a car and the dealer threw in a free MOT.
throw off	quickly remove an item of clothing	I can't wait to throw off my dress and put my pyjamas on.
throw on	quickly add an item of clothing/accessory	I threw some make-up on and left as quickly as I could.
throw out	discard or be expelled	I'm going shopping! First, I need to throw out some of my old clothes.
throw together	make something quickly	I forgot I have an assignment due tomorrow. I'll have to throw one together this evening.
throw up	vomit	The baby threw up all over my new blouse.
