wash away	land/buildings/dirt etc. is carried away by water	I need to take my make-up off; I want to wash away the remains of the night before.
wash down	drink something to help you swallow	I hate taking medicine. I usually wash it down with a glass of orange juice.
wash out	remove colour/stains/dirt etc. or a total disaster	My party was a total wash out, only five people turned up.
wash up	clean the dishes or something in the ocean is pushed to the shore	If I make dinner, will you wash up?
