

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'WHIP'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
whip into	stimulate someone into a specified state	The commentators are whipping the crowd into a frenzy.
whip off	remove quickly	Whip off your uniform and I'll wash it for you.
whip out	present something quickly	Mr. Barker whipped out his pen and signed the contract.
whip round	do something quickly	I don't want to spend too long in the supermarket, so I'll just whip round with my list.
whip through	do something quickly	I'll whip through section 5 as it's getting late and I want to go home.
whip up	make something quickly or excite a crowd	The presenter whipped up the crowd before the headliners arrived on stage.
