

PHRASAL VERBS WITH 'WORK'

phrasal verb	meaning	example
work around	deal with a problem that prevents you from achieving your goal	We worked around the problems and got the order out on time.
work in	add/integrate something	Once you have worked in the dried fruit, the mixture is ready for baking.
work off	exercise to remove weight/stress/anger or work to pay off a debt	It will take me 7 years to work off my university debts.
work on	spend time developing/improving something	I worked on my project all night, but it still isn't finished.
work out	the end result, find the solution or exercise	I didn't want to be partnered with Jane, but it worked out well in the end.
work through	deal with/solve a problem or work during a specified period	We are working through our marriage problems. I don't want another divorce.
work up	when a person gets angry/excited/upset	The kids are worked up about Christmas, they won't sleep for the next week.
