pillow talk	intimate conversation between lovers	I think he's seeing someone else, we never have pillow talk anymore.
small talk	casual/trivial conversation	Can you make small talk with the clients until we're ready to start the meeting?
talk of the devil	when a person you are talking about arrives	Talk of the devil! We were just talking about you Stanley.
talk shop	discuss work	Our husbands are mechanics, so they're always talking shop when they're together.
talk someone into	persuade someone to do something	We need to talk Alex into driving us to that rave in Bristol.
talk someone out of something	persuade someone not to do something	I talked myself out of running the marathon, I'm just too lazy.
talk the hind leg off a donkey	someone who talks a lot/for a long time	I hate Andrew's meetings, they last hours. That man could talk the hind leg off a donkey.
