idiom	meaning	example
a round of golf	a game of golf (18 holes)	Do you fancy a few rounds of golf at the weekend? I want to test out my new clubs.
hole in one	a shot that enters the hole on the first hit in golf	I got a hole in one, it was a total fluke.
par for the course	what is normal/typical/expected	Dropping out of college is a par for the course these days.
up to par	satisfactory, acceptable	The main course was nice, but the dessert wasn't up to par.
