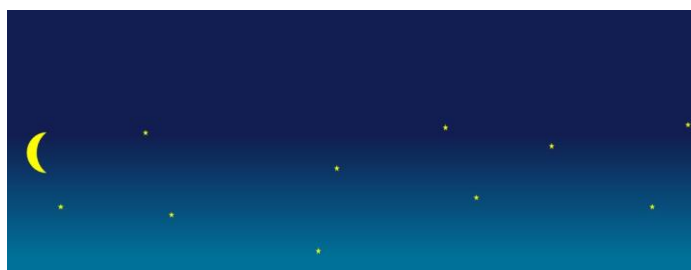


DARK IDIOMS AND EXPRESSIONS

idiom	meaning	example
dark horse	an unknown competitor or a person who keeps their talents secret	The dark horse, Duke Runalot beat the favourites to win the race.
keep in the dark	unaware, uninformed	Why are they keeping me in the dark? I want to know how serious the accident was.
whistle in the dark	pretend not to be afraid in difficult times or guess aimlessly	The boss thinks we'll be inundated with orders next month. I think he's whistling in the dark.
