idiom	meaning	example
as easy as one, two, three	something is very easy	Using the new machinery is as easy as one, two, three.
as easy as pie	very easy, simple	The exam was as easy as pie, I've definitely passed.
easy come, easy go	you aren't bothered about losing something (especially money)	My girlfriend dumped me, easy come, easy go.
easy does it	tell someone to be careful and not use too much effort	Easy does it! You don't want to get caught speeding.
easy money	money earned with little effort (sometimes dishonestly)	Kerry works for her dad. She hates it but it's easy money.
easy on the eye	attractive, good looking	The guy I'm seeing is easy on the eye, but he isn't intelligent.
easy peasy (lemon squeezy)	very easy	Follow this recipe, it's easy peasy and she will be really impressed.
take it easy	relax and don't do much	I took It easy at the weekend, I've got a few busy weeks coming up.
